However, most seniors, many of whom are healthy and active, still feel unsafe about living alone because no one would know if they needed help”.

Anyware Solutions is providing these seniors and their families with an ethical, non-wearable and preventive plug-and-play care monitoring solution.

The solution is based on existing smart home technology with advanced AI anomaly detection of seniors living alone, which is 1 in every third senior above 65 years across Europe, and designed for the informal caregivers that looks after that senior person.
